

FAQs

Q: What is the date/time of the conference?

A: The conference is held on April 12th from 9:00 AM - 5 PM. Check-in begins at 8:30 AM and check-out begins at 5 PM in the second floor ConocoPhillips Atrium. Please look at the map on our website for more details.

Q: How do I register for the conference?

Q: When does registration close?

A: Applications will not be accepted past **11:59 PM on February 17th**. The deadline to register if accepted is **March 10th**.

Q: Where is EnVision taking place this year?

A: EnVision will take place at the Zachry Engineering Building on the Texas A&M Campus.

Q: Where can I drop off and pick up my student?

A: You may drop off and pick up your student at the Zachry Engineering Building. Additionally, you may park at lots 47, 50, 51, 54. Please see the attached document on our website for specific details!

Q: What is included with registration?

A: Included with the registration fee is a lunch, conference goodies, a t-shirt, and a full day of activities!

Q: What is the grade range for each category?

A: 9th - 12th grade can participate in the EnVision Scholars Conference. The conference is not exclusive to students from the College Station/Bryan area!

Q: What are the competitions included with the Spring Scholars Conference?

A: The Spring Scholars Conference will have 2 competitions for students. Our team is hosting a Grand Design Challenge in which all students will participate in smaller teams to accomplish an engineering task and society competitions hosted by varying Texas A&M Engineering organizations.

Q: What time does check-in start?

A: The spring Envision Scholars Conference check-in will begin at 8:30 AM.

Q: How much does the EnVision Scholars Conference cost?

A: This conference has a \$20 fee that includes a t-shirt, swag bag, lunch, and a full-day conference.

Q: Can someone else pick up my student?

A: You must indicate who is picking up when you drop a student off and authorize it as the guardian. If you fail to do this, you will be called in order to authorize the pick up later in the day, which will delay your student's pick up.

Q: Can my student(s) drive themselves?

A: No, students may only drive themselves if they are 18 or older.
